Jacob West roars into top 5 with best finish this season as Toye takes July's Formula 1

While names often associated with Formula One racing at Willow Springs were heard frequently this weekend, (sometimes in surprising situations) a moniker not often uttered by track announcers was repeated frequently this month as Jacob West (WSMC # 86) found his best finish of the season racing against pros who've been at this awhile.

WSMC top points leader Marc Palazzo, in his first Formula One start of the season found himself in the dirt just moments after the race began as he tumbled in a crowded turn one.

Perennial Formula 1 favorite Jeremy Toye (#57) maintained the lead until the race was red flagged when two other racers, Clinton Whitehouse (# 9) and John Chen (#73) rode off the track in turn 3 in spectacular tumbles. While moderate injuries were reported, neither of the riders required transport.

When the race resumed with a 10-lap restart, Dowie gained a lead in the early running, but by lap two succumbed to Toye who held onto the front spot for the remainder of the race. Dowie held onto second place while Landers and Stern fought for third. But perhaps the most surprising finish came from Jacob West who in only his second F-1 appearance this season moved from 19th on the grid to edge out Stephen Hewitt (# 28), Bryan Kovarick (#391) and Dale Kieffer(#725) to take fifth place.

West whose best prior finish had been 7th in 750 Superstock had a good weekend with a 2nd in 750 SS, two 3rd place finishes in 750 MP and Solo GTO along with his fifth place showing in Formula One. His overall points nearly tripled from 16 to 48.

Rounding out the top ten finishers were Hewitt in 6th, Kovarick, who took 7th, Kieffer earned 8th, while Brian Steeves (#201), another newcomer, finished 9th. Ruben Munoz Jr. (#714) earned the 10th position. All top ten finishers qualify for the Toyota Tundra drawing that will be awarded to one lucky rider at the end of the season.

Palazzo holds onto Points lead despite mishap and missed starts

Mark Palazzo's firm lead shrunk a bit after a mishap in F-1 racing shortened his race day in July. But he still managed to earn 31 pts with two first place finishes earlier in the day. Stoney Landers edged closer to Palazzo, earning 35 pts with a second and two 3rd place finishes. Will Eikenberry advanced the most earning 45 pts with 3 first place finishes. Jeff Stern edged out Sam Carnibucci for 4th place earning 41 pts this month, while Sam fell to 5th place with 35 points. Moving up from 8th place last month to 6th this month is Robbie Dowie who earned 41pts. With his off-road excursion in the Formula One race, Clinton Whitehouse dropped from 6th to 7th place, despite earning a respectable 27 pts earlier in the day. Skye Girard also fell a bit in the standings, earning this months No 8 slot with 15 new points. Rounding out the top ten were Blair Sullenger, with 23 pts added, and Jeremy Toye with two wins earning him 30 pts this month.

SPOTLIGHT ON ... **Golden West Trailers Formula 2**

Eikenberry, Carnibucci and Lane in Classic Battle

Golden West Trailers Formula 2 race saw two veteran WSMC riders, Sam Carnibucci (WSMC # 8) and Will Eikenberry (# 87) battle against a relative new face this season at Willow Springs, Mickey Lane (#262). Through the first $\frac{3}{4}$ of the race Carnibucci held firmly onto the lead with Lane and Eikenberry exchanging the second slot briefly in lap five. But in lap seven, spectators soon learned where there's a Will there's a way ... and Eikenberry overtook Carnibucci and began to separate himself from the other two. Carnibucci and Lane continued to battle wheel to wheel for second place. On the final lap, Mickey managed to best Sam in the troublesome turn three (where earlier several riders had tumbled) and got the edge on second place. Throughout the remaining 2 miles, the two continued to battle for position and as it came down to the wire, both gave it all they had to finish nearly wheel to wheel. In one of the closest races of the day, officials called Lane the 2nd place winner and Carnibucci 3rd. A great race!

ALL bikes must have belly pans installed by October 15th, 2004. There are no exceptions.

Bikes not properly equipped will not be allowed on the track.

Racer Reminders

Hot Pit Reminder

The only people authorized to be in the hot pit lane are licensed riders and mechanics and track/event officials. Please do not enter the hot pit lane (the area north of the gold wall) unless you belong there. Always keep hot pit entry and exit areas clear. Thanks.

Number Readability

Plate numbers (particularly 3-digit numbers) continue to be a challenge to scorers. Please check your numbers before the next meet and if in doubt acquire a fresh set from the Willow Springs Gift Shop or your favorite supplier. Thanks for your cooperation.

Know Your Neighbors

It's a good idea to get to know your neighbors in the pits. Many long-lasting friendships have started that way and your neighbors can often help you out should the need arise. They can keep an eye on things while you are away, and should you need to leave the track unexpectedly can assist you in taking care of any loose ends. It is also a good idea to note the space number of your pit to accommodate deliveries or to help others locate you. So be a good neighbor ... offer help to those next door and ask for help when you need it. Think of it as Willow Spring's answer to a Neighborhood Watch program!

Show Your License At Registration

Riders are reminded that you MUST show your license when you check in each day. We will not issue tech slips to anyone who does not possess a valid WSMC license. If you have yet to pick up your 2004 photo license, visit the photo office upstairs BEFORE you attempt to check in for practice or racing.

Contingency Programs

Kawasaki and Suzuki both have contingencies available to qualified WSMC members in August. Remember, when applying for any contingency awards, it is your responsibility to make sure you meet the sponsor's eligibility requirements and you must turn in all contingency forms at tech inspection BEFORE the start of your races. Make sure you are racing in a class with contingencies before turning in unnecessary forms and be sure to fill out all of the information that the manufacturer has requested. Thanks.

Sponsors, Hometowns & Pronunciation

Want to make sure you enjoy your 15 seconds of fame when we announce your name or publish your great finish? Then make sure we have accurate and current information in the WSMC office. If you have an unusual name, please provide us with hints on how to properly pronounce it. All information must be received by the WSMCE office no later than 8am on Race Day, so we can incorporate it into everything we put out – announcer sheets, race results, PR, etc. Changes will only be accepted from licensed WSMC racers.

Race Results

Please take the time to check race results before you leave the track to verify that you were scored properly in your event. Note that any protests must be filed within 30 minutes of the race finish. Only clerical or scoring errors will be corrected after results become official. WSMC reserves the right to reclassify riders, revise race results and retroactively award points and awards should any error be found in the originally posted event results.

If you are among the top three finishers in a race, please pick up your award(s) before you leave the track. They will only be held at the WSMC office for 60 days.

From The Track Office

Kids and The Pits

Parents and hosts of children under 16 are reminded that the pit and paddock areas can be a hazardous place. Please always keep your kids under immediate supervision anywhere in the pits. In "Pit Row", that area between the WSMC office and Hartman Garages and just south of the gold wall is particularly hazardous due to race bikes entering and exiting the track. For this reason, no person under sixteen may ride anything in the "Pit Row" area. Please instruct children to walk, push or carry their bikes, skateboards and/or scooters through this area. Kids who repeatedly ignore this rule, will have their vehicles impounded. Parents may pick up the impounded vehicle at the track office after the event.

Also remember that appropriate safety gear should always be worn when riding elsewhere on WSIR property.

Your cooperation in seeing that these rules are observed is greatly appreciated.



Top Rookie Expert Program

The Top Rookie Expert (TRE) competition tallies the success of riders who have moved up from Novice to Expert during the current season. TRE points are based on Overall Expert Points earned from April through December. This allows new Novice racers completing their upgrade requirements in the first quarter, to compete head-to-head with Novices carrying over from a prior season. Novices who move up to Expert after April will be tallied from the first month they earn Expert points. Novice upgrade points are not counted. TRE awards are presented to the top three point holders at the end of the season.
