Transponders Coming to WSMC in 2005

WSMC is pleased to announce a major change in timing and scoring techniques. Effective January 2005, all WSMC events will be scored via AMB transponders.

AMB is the world leader in motor sport transponders, used by AMA Pro, WERA, Champ Car, IRL, NASCAR, IMSA, World Series Superbikes, Moto Grand Prix, and the 24 hours of Le Mans, to name but a few. AMB has been producing high-performance timing and scoring systems for over 20 years, and is the world's leader in systems for virtually all forms of motorsports and high-end athletic sports.

Transponders will be available for purchase or rent through WSMC at a special discounted rate exclusively for our members. AMB TranX260 Rechargeable Transponder kits which retail for \$329 from AMB will be available for just \$280, a 15% savings.

An introductory rental rate of \$40 will be offered in January. The

normal weekend rental rate will be \$60 per transponder. If you are a frequent racer at Willow Springs, the purchase program will likely make the most sense. The devices carry a three-year warranty and can be financed over 90 days through the club.

This new equipment will not only make scoring more accurate and timely, accurate lap times will be available throughout the weekend to assist riders and crews in tuning their gear for optimal performance. Integration of real time results with the web site will make this information available anywhere, within minutes of becoming official. Look for details at December's event.

Palazzo Nears Lock on 2005 # 1 Plate

The probability of anyone other than Marc Palazzo gaining the # 1 plate narrowed when no championship points were awarded at the abbreviated November event. Palazzo's 28 point lead seems unbeatable. Will Eikenberry also has a firm hold on second place while current # 1 plate holder Jeff Stern looks like he has dibs on the #3 plate in 2005.

Meanwhile, the race for 4th, 5th and 6th is very close with Clinton Whitehouse just 4 points ahead of Robbie Dowie and Sam Carnibucci who are currently tied for fifth. Failure to fill out forms completely, leads to inaccuracies in our records, which mean bad information on announcements, score sheets, and worse trouble qualifying for contingencies! Make sure we have all your current information by filling out your forms.

Important Notes

If you have a mishap at the track and require medical attention, you are required to provide a medical release before you can participate in WSMC practices or races.

If you switch bikes/riders at any time during an event weekend you MUST notify the tower each and every time you make a switch.

Switching is not allowed on Sundays!



Carryover Information

Due to the abbreviated schedule run in November, many riders qualify for carryovers. Here are details spelled out in the rulebook:

Experts, Probational Experts and Pros

If you were entered in only one race, that entry fee is forfeited to cover the cost of fielding practice, corner workers and safety crews. If you were entered in more than one race, you may call or fax the WSMC Office to request a carry-over for any races beyond your first entry that were not run. Keep in mind that November's carry-overs must be used by February, 2005 or they are lost.

Novice Racers

Novice riders entered into a race and participating in practice will be entitled to one free 2nd entry upon moving out of Novice and becoming a Probational Expert. This is not the rule, but an exception for an extraordinary situation.

No Championship Points, No TRE Points for November

As noted elsewhere, no championship points were awarded for the November event due to the incomplete race schedule. Also no Top Rookie Expert Points were awarded. Class points were awarded in the six classes that ran in November. These include: Aprilla Challenge, Vintage Heavyweight Dinosaurs, BOTT Lightweight, 650cc Superbike, BOTT Middleweight, and Vintage Lightweight. Sorry but we are unable to offer double points in December, but note that purses have been doubled on all classes that did not run.

2005 Number Assignment Information

Each year, there is much confusion and frustration over number assignments. To help you understand the process a little better, we have prepared the following fact sheet for your information.

1. You can renew your membership and retain your current number (over 10) immediately. Appropriate forms are included in this month's newsletter and can also be downloaded from the website. You must return your completed forms along with your membership fee BEFORE December 31st to assure yourself of the same number.
2. Numbers NOT renewed by December 31st are subject to reassignment *without notice*.
3. NO NUMBERS WILL CHANGE UNTIL AFTER JANUARY 1st, 2005. Please note it is not possible to "reserve" a number that is already assigned.
4. Novice Racers will be assigned numbers from 500 and up
5. Probational Experts and Full Experts who do not finish in the Top 100 overall in 2004 will be assigned numbers from 101 and up. Probationary Experts and Experts may choose a number above 500 if they wish. Riders may request a vacant number (or numbers) when renewing, but no numbers will be reassigned until after New Years. All requests will be honored on a first-come, first-served basis.
6. Two digit numbers will only be assigned to riders who finish in the Top 100 in Championship points for 2004 or to current two-digit number holders who renew by December 31st.
7. Number availability is limited. Riders with current WSMC number assignments may renew them and keep them no matter what their final 2004 point standing is. Riders who finish in the top 100 and request the number that they finish may receive a number higher or lower depending on availability after January 1st.
8. Numbers 1 through 10 are automatically assigned to those finishing in the top 10 overall. Should a top 10 rider vacate their 2005 number assignment, available single digit WSMC numbers will only be assigned to current o++++r past National Champions as recognized by WSMC and/or past WSMC/Willow Springs Raceway Overall Track Champions.
9. 2005 Licensed WSMC racers may call the WSMC Office starting Wednesday, January 5th, 2005 after 2:00pm to inquire regarding the 2005 number assignments. PLEASE DO NOT CALL PRIOR TO THIS DATE.

Top Rookie Expert Program

The Top Rookie Expert (TRE) competition tallies the success of riders who have moved up from Novice to Expert during the current season. TRE points are based on Overall Expert Points earned from April through December. This allows new Novice racers completing their upgrade requirements in the first quarter, to compete head-to-head with Novices carrying over from a prior season. Novices who move up to Expert after April will be tallied from the first month they earn Expert points. Novice upgrade points are not counted. TRE awards are presented to the top three point holders at the end of the season.
