LOWRY LEADS T-CUP END-TO-END

'08 #1 Placeholder takes Feb Formula One

Rosamond, CA - WSMC's Karl Lowry (#1) showed fans and competitors how he earned the right to ride Number One this weekend as he handily took home top honors in the second round of the Toyota Cup Formula One Series held at the historic Willow Springs Raceway in Rosamond.

Riverside-based Lowry lead a pack of top riders aboard his Graves Motorsports tuned Yamaha, steadily turning 1:20's while others ran 1:21's. 2nd place went to San Diegan Jeremy Toye (#57) who finished a full five seconds behind Lowry. Attack Kawasaki's Steve Rapp (#315) took third, just 4/10ths of a second behind Toye.

Young Michael Beck (#360) finished 4th followed by former Toyota 200 champ Josh Hayes (#113), veteran Jeff Stern (#2) and WSMC newcomer Chaz Davies (#570). Rounding out the top ten were 2007 Toyota Truck winner, Robbie Dowie (#4). Chris Duran (#5) and Reno Kavimian (#418).

Karl Lowry (#1) is off to a strong start in his quest to retain WSMC's #1 plate for a second season. He currently tops the leader board 20 points ahead of his closest competitors, Jeff Stern (#2) and Michael Beck (#360). They are a point apart at 101 and 100 points respectively. Andy Palmer (#111) is ranked 4th with 80 points, followed by Andrew Price (#665) who has racked up 76 points to his name. Robbie Dowie (#4) is close on his tail with 75 points followed by Chris Duran (#5) with 72. Two Ryans, Gagliano (#7) and Regalado (#248) have 8th and 9th slots under control with 68 and 65 points respectively. Michael Baird (#52) follows close behind with 64 points to round out the top ten list as of February's meeting of the Willow Springs Motorcycle Club.

PRICE & PALMER PUT ON QUITE A SHOW

Rivals battle it out in two races with split-second finishes

They share first names and last initials, but Andrew (Drew) Price (#665) and Andrew (Andy) Palmer (#111) are different racers. Andy is a veteran with 5 years of WSMC racing. Drew just graduated from the rookie ranks in 2007. Together, however they know how to create exciting racing. The two have paired up since Drew advanced from Novice in 2007. In their first head-to-head outing, Palmer took two 2nd place's to Price's 3rd & 4th. In December's 550SB, Palmer had 1st, Price 5th. Things got closer in January, when Price took 2nd while Palmer won the race. But in February, Price showed he had the right stuff by taking both Race 8 and Race 14 by the slightest margins. He beat out Palmer by only .012 second in the West Coast GP Formula Twins and by only .037 second in the Little Big Racing Services 550 Superbike contest. That's what great racing is all about! Keep up the competition guys. We love it!
